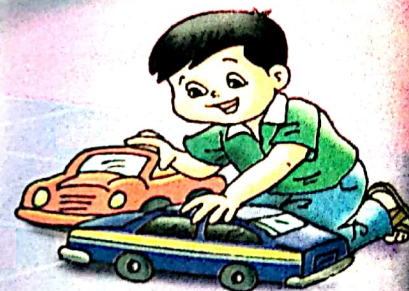
I WAS ONE
Not a baby but a son.

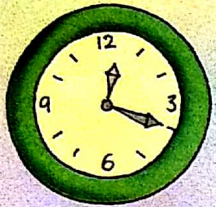
I WAS TWO
